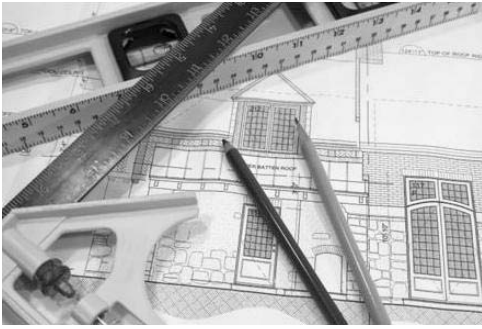


Dear Bill,

As an incentive to encourage residents and business owners to renovate their property, the Village of Palm Springs is again offering financial assistance, on a reimbursement basis, for construction projects that 1) require a building permit, 2) cost at least \$500, and 3) enhance the visual appeal and value of the residence/business. 2 weeks left of Summer Camp 2016. Space is still available!



There are still spaces available for the last 2 weeks of Camp F.L.I.P.S (Fun and Learning in Palm Springs) as well as Teen Camp. Camp hours are from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. with scheduled activities between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Campers will go on age-appropriate field trips such as the pool, the Rapids Water Park, Calypso Bay, the movies, bowling, and the zoo to name just a few of the trips that are still planned during the final 2 weeks of camp. This camp is for children age 5 (must have completed Kindergarten) all the way up to 12 for Camp F.L.I.P.S. and 13 to 15 for Teen Camp.

There is a registration fee of \$25 per child which includes the 5 camp t-shirts. The weekly fee is \$125 per child which includes all arts and crafts supplies and field trips, along with breakfast and lunch as part of the school lunch program.

Back to School Safety Tips

Whether children walk, ride their bicycle or take the bus to school, it is extremely important that they take proper safety precautions. Here are some tips to make sure your child arrives safely each day.



Walking to School

Review your family's walking safety rules.

- Walk on the sidewalk, if one is available, and if on a street with no sidewalk, walk facing the traffic.
- Before you cross the street, stop and look left, right and left again to see if cars are coming.
- Never dart out in front of a parked car.
- Practice walking to school with your child. Cross streets at crosswalks when available, and always obey School Crossing Guards.

Riding a Bicycle to School

Make sure your child always wears his/her helmet.

- Make sure the helmet is fitted and secured properly.
- Teach your children the rules of the road.
- Ride on the right side of the road, with traffic, and in a single file.
- Come to a complete stop before crossing the street and walk your bike across the street.

Riding the Bus to School

- Go to the bus stop with your child, and show them the proper way to enter and exit the bus.
- Make sure your children stand six feet away (or 3 giant steps) from the curb.
- If you need to cross the street in front of a bus, walk on the side of the road until you are 10 feet ahead of the bus and make sure you are able to see the Bus Driver and the Bus Driver can see you before crossing the street.
