Clean and Safe***

The Village of Palm Springs contracts with [Republic Services](#) for all solid waste collection

services. Services are provided every day of the year except Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Years. Residential collection services include:

- Twice per week pick-up of garbage
- Once per week for recycling
- Once per week for yard trash
- Once per week for bulk trash

Garbage carts, recycling containers, yard trash and bulk trash may not be placed curbside until after 4:00 PM the day before pick-up, and should be placed there no later than 7:00 AM on pick-up day. The Village of Palm Springs Summer Co-ed [Youth Basketball](#) Program will once again be held at the Palm Springs Middle School and John I. Leonard High School gymnasiums. Registration is underway and will continue until Friday, May 26th. The league is open to boys & girls ages eight to seventeen based on their age at the beginning of this School year, Sept. 1st, 2016.

The cost is \$85 for residents and \$115 for non-residents and includes a playing jersey. If you register prior to Saturday, May 13th, you will receive a \$10 discount. 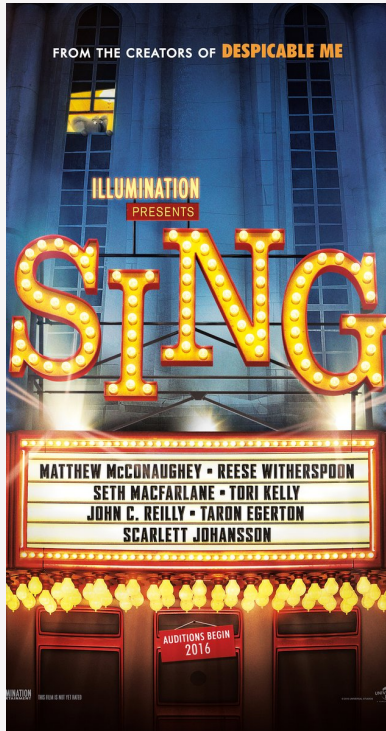

Whether walking or riding a bicycle, children need to know how to respond safely and properly on sidewalks and streets. Let's start now to build your child's traffic safety knowledge and skills. participate in this event. All participants will be required to wear a bike helmet. If your child does not have a bike helmet, we will be giving them away while supplies last.

There will also be a bicycle trick demonstration from local athletes. There is no charge for this event, so don't let your child miss this important opportunity to learn and practice bicycle safety skills at this clinic!

### **Deadline to apply for [Property Improvement \(Matching\) Grant Program](#) is Friday, May 5th**

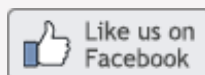
